A little damage to the plumbing system occurred over the winter with frozen valves and sprinklers, but, the pool came out in pretty good shape.

The Board decided after consulting with an arborist that the tree in front of the snack bar needed help. The tree was in a sad state. It was decided that the tree would be removed, and as of this date has been completely removed.

The exterior grounds were also badly overgrown. Since the vandalism issue has been a problem over the last couple of years, having the pool area visible will help in cutting down the after-hours

vandalism. Many hours and lots of hard work now have most of the pool area cleared out. This will also reduce our fire hazard, due to the reduction of the Manzanita which covered the front areas.
